Program 5th National `Ashrah Ta`limul Qur'an (1-10 January, 2017) and 26th National Winter Ta`limul Qur'an Classes

(Minimum One day Class during 8-10 Jan. 2016, and Jalsa Qur'an Karim)

In accordance with the Recommendation No.4 of Majlis Shura, 2011, approved by Hazrat Khalifatul-Masih V^{aa}, the National Department of Ta`limul Qur'an is holding a Canadawide `Ashrah Ta`limul Qur'an at Imarat/Region or Local Jama`at levels, during January 1-10, 2017, as indicated in the National Calendar of Events-2017.

This Program also includes the Program of 26th National Winter Ta`limul Qur'an Classes and Jalsa Qur'an Karim (Syllabus Outline Annex-2) to be held Canada-wide on any one day during 6-8 January, 2017. Salient features of this important `Ashrah Program are given below and all Imaraat and Jama`ats are advised to ensure its implementation in a befitting manner:

- 1. Announcement on Dec.31, 2016: Make detailed Announcement after Maghrib Prayer to introduce the Program of Ashra Ta`limul Qur'an and urge Jama`at members for maximum participation in congregational Prayers and daily recitation of the Holy Qur'an as instructed by our beloved Imam.
- **2.** Tahajjud Prayer in Congregation on January. 01, 2017 (Sunday): At the start of `Ashrah Ta`limul Qur'an, please hold congregational Tahajjud Prayer on January 1, 2017.
- 3. 50th Anniversary Project of 1000 Waqifin `Ardhi: Please note that our beloved Imam has graciously instructed to increase the number of Waqfin from 313 to 1000. During the Ashra, please run a campaign for maximum participation in this blessed Project (by filling the Pledge Forms) at the rate of at least one Waqif per 10 Jama`at members. Each Waqif must offer at least one week or 3 weekends.
- **4. Special Campaign of Ta`limul Qur'an:** All Secretaries Ta`limul Qur'an are advised to run a special campaign under guidance of the Local Umaraa, Presidents and the Missionaries, as follows:

- Office of Secretary Ta`limul Qur'an: If this Office is vacant, please make a request to the National General Secretary for election or nomination.
- Classes by Missionaries: Provide full support for maximum attendance in their regular daily/weekly Ta`limul Qur'an Classes in the light of various Friday Sermons of Huzur Anwar^{aa}, especially that of August 16, 2013.
- Arrange Durus (after daily Prayers) of Qur'anic Verses and Ahadith related to the Holy Qur'an (See BRE), and present excerpts from *Hamari Ta`lim* (Kashti Nuh) and other books of the Promised Messiah^{as})
- Remind all Jama'at members, especially the **Office Bearers**, *Musian* and *A'immatus-Salat* to learn correct recitation and translation of the Holy Qur'an, and open new regular Ta'limul Qur'an Classes wherever needed in your Jama'at.
- **5. 26**th **National Winter Ta`limul Qur'an Classes and Jalsa Qur'an Karim:** Please hold these Classes (any day during 8-10 January, 2016) as per Syllabus enclosed at Annex-2, and hold **Jalsa Qur'an-e-Karim preferably on January 8, Sunday**.
- **6. Friday Sermon on January 06, 2017:** All *A'immatus-Salat* are advised to deliver the Friday sermon on, "*Distinctive Features of the Holy Qur'an"*.
