# Additional Instructions for Virtual Format of Waqf 'Ārḍi

Please note that primarily the Waqf 'Ārdi Guidelines provided with the Application Forms should be followed. However, due to the virtual format of Waqf 'Ārdi, a few additional instructions are given below:

The Virtual Waqf 'Ārdi shall be performed from one's home with consistent communication with the assigned Jamā'at members in consultation with the Local Amīr or Sadr.

There are two components of Waqf 'Ārdi:

- 1. Self-Reformation
- 2. Performance of assigned duties of Ta'līmul Qur'ān , Tarbiyat, Tablīgh or any other assigned duty

# Self-Reformation

Start your Waqf with fervent prayers and sending a letter to Hazrat Khalīfatul-Masīh V (may Allah be his Helper!) for prayers. A typical daily schedule of a Wāqif 'Ārḍi is suggested as follows:

- Observance of Tahajjud Prayer and five daily Prayers in congregation with family members.
- After Fajr Prayer, recitation of the Holy Qur'an at dawn, with translation (of at least two Rukus).
- Study of Barakatud Du'a (Blessings of the Prayer) by the Promised Messiah (as) with family members if possible.
- Istighfar, prayers prescribed by Huzoor Anwar (aa) and two Rak'at Nawafil.

# **Assigned Duties**

An overview of these duties is given below:

- Contacting assigned Jamā'at members to inquire about their wellbeing especially in the present Pandemic situation and offering help if needed.
- Trying to help the family regarding Tarbiyat matters and advising them to be regular in five daily prayers and recitation of the Holy Qur'ān.
- Teaching correct recitation and translation of the of the Holy Qur'ān.
- Helping a Jamā'at member to talk to a Tablīgh contact if needed.
- Preparing for each family member a simple statistical Data Form separately attached.

# Waqf 'Ārdi Report

It is very important to fill in the Report Form attached to the Application Form indicating your activities and salient features and experiences of your Waqf 'Ārḍi.
